

Friday, December 7th, 7:00pm [SL 300] Family Genealogy 101 with Karen Kiaer

In her new book, Ancestors Through My Eyes: The Story of An American Family - The Ingersolls of Massachusetts, New York and Michigan: 1620 - 1920, Karen Kiaer weaves the stories of eleven generations of Ingersolls and 400 years of history into a compelling and personal family history. Not only did she learn a lot about her family's past, she also learned how to conduct genealogical research. Ms. Kiaer, who is Chapter Historian for the Shelter Island NSDAR (National Society of the Daughters of the American Revolution), will talk about her ancestors and how you might uncover your own family's story using genealogical tools. Saturday, December 15th, 11:00am A Room with a View by E.M. Forster



ART/RICH POETRY ROUNDTABLE, A LITERARY CLUB


Tuesdays, December 4th, 11th and 18th, 4:00 to 5:30pm
