DAYS GONE BY

The library will be 135 years old this year. Much has happened since Eben Norton Horsford cleared out a shoe cupboard in the "Old Store" to hold stacks of books in 1895. After the Old Store burned to the ground, a new library was erected which also served as a museum housing the Willis M. Worthington Natural History and Curio Collection. That collection consisted of stuffed birds, snakes, animals, and "Indian relics from around the USA." While the birds and snakes were later donated to a museum, a framed collection of arrowheads now hangs over the DVD collection.

Her memoir For the Love of Horses, features her stunning depictions of the horses she has known, as well as stories of friends and neighbors who share her love of these magnificent animals.
